Starting Vegetable Seeds Indoors



- Some vegetables can be directly planted outdoors after the last chance of frost: see each seed packet for individual details.
- You can start herb seeds anytime indoors for immediate growth and harvest.
- Start your vegetable seeds indoors 6-8 weeks before the expected last frost date. See individual packets for details.

Temperature: 70-75 degrees F is just right for seed germination.

Soil: You can start the seeds in seed starter pellets or peat pots so when it is time, you can just plant the entire thing outside. After the seeds have the second set of real leaves, you then transplant the pellets into peat pots to continue the process, until it is time to transplant outdoors. Press the seeds into the planting mix to the depth recommended on the seed packet. Water with a misting spray bottle or with a fine overhead spray from a watering can. Keep the growing medium evenly moist, but never waterlogged.

- After the last frost you can transplant your seedlings outdoors. See individual packets for details on spacing and height.
